Mordialloc CC Treasurer's Report 2021/22

After a successful 2020/21 season through all the Covid restrictions and limitations, we were set up for a good start to the 2021/22 season but we were wary of the limitations that any Covid restrictions could pose again. The start of the season was again hampered with Covid restrictions, density limits and some functions had to be cancelled which hampered the fundraising abilities by the club, including any Bunnings BBQ's.

Notwithstanding the limitations of the season, we had another 78 registrations raising just under \$10,000 for membership fees which is an excellent result for the year. Similar to last year, it was decided to keep membership fees the same and have junior **R**edbacks play for the seniors at no cost.

Andy's Kitchen was a great success again with Thursday, Friday and Saturday meals and we would like to thank Andy and Rachel for running this each week and the effort they have put in over the last season.

The biggest source of revenue for the season was sponsorship income. From these great supporters of the club during the 2021/22 season we managed to secure \$22,750 from external sponsors: Bendigo Bank, Kwickaz Transport, ATS Timber Supplies, More Building Group, MF Freight, Complete Plumbing, DJM Building Group, Co Working Solutions, Fido Projects, JRB Tiling and Titan Cricket.

The 2021/22 season was again a difficult season and with reduced sponsorship, limitations on functions and fundraising activities, the Mordialloc Cricket Club is still in a strong position to move into the 2022/23 season where we are hoping for an uninterrupted season and a tilt at a few premierships.

Thanks again to all the volunteers that made the season possible.





Mordialloc CC 4th XI Captain's Report 2021/22

Season 2022 saw the last year's 5ths step up to the 4ths to provide a clearer pathway to develop the younger talent into senior cricket. Along with that came a jump up two grades into I grade cricket. With the momentum the team had developed at the end of season 2021, we were hoping this would help grow the boys confidence levels to make the jump up and importantly be competitive.

This season saw 35 players rotated through the team with some experienced players returning to cricket after long breaks and a host of juniors making the step up to senior cricket.

In round 2, we saw Jethro Cox make his senior debut against CUCC Kings that will forever be known as the infamous "tiegate." Jethro was rock solid scoring 22 on debut and later in the season was elevated to the 3rds and having a strong first year with the senior club.

We also saw Jarvis Barr come up from the U14's – he also had a ripper debut against East Bentleigh Central taking 2/23 and bamboozling the opposition with his wrist spin.
