

# R9. Mordialloc Cricket Club - Alcohol Management Policy

## R9.1 MCC Bar Management

1. Alcohol will be served according to the requirements of the club's liquor licence and in accordance with the safety and wellbeing of patrons.
2. Only Official MCC Bar Staff who have completed a Responsible Serving of Alcohol (RSA) course will be permitted to serve alcohol.
3. The club will discourage excessive or rapid consumption of alcohol.
4. Alcoholic drinks will be served in standard drink measures.
5. The club will display posters on Blood Alcohol Content and the ways alcohol affects the body.
6. The liquor licence will be displayed at the bar.

## R9.2 Minors

1. Alcohol will not be served to minors.
2. Staff will request proof of age, where appropriate.
3. Only photographic ID will be accepted

## R9.3 Intoxicated people

1. Alcohol will not be served to any person who is intoxicated.
2. Servers will follow procedures, provided in their training by the Liquor Licensing Commission, for dealing with and refusing alcohol to intoxicated patrons.
3. Intoxicated patrons will be asked to leave the club.
4. The club will encourage & facilitate safe transport options.

## R9.4 Sale & Promotion of Alcohol

1. The club will actively demonstrate its attitude relating to the responsible use of alcohol.
2. The club will not advertise, promote or serve full-strength alcohol at junior events or activities.
3. The club will educate club members and supporters about the alcohol policy.
4. The club will pursue non-alcohol sponsorship and revenue sources.
5. The club will provide alcohol-free social events for young people and families.
6. Alcohol advertising will only appear at the bar.

## R9.5 Low Alcohol & Alcohol – free drink alternatives

1. The club will provide a selection of low-cost, low-alcohol and alcohol-free drinks at the bar.
2. Free jugs of water will be available at the bar.
3. A range of low-alcohol and non-alcoholic drinks will be actively promoted and sold at prices competitive with those of full-strength alcoholic drinks.
4. Tea and coffee will be available at the bar during social functions.

## R9.6 Provision of Food

1. The club will actively promote and provide a range of snacks and meals when alcohol is served.
2. The club will actively promote and sell food whenever alcohol is available.
3. The club will provide a range of attractive, nourishing and inexpensive snacks and meals.
4. The club will use food or canteen awards rather than alcohol as prizes for player performance.

## R9.7 Safe Transport

1. The club will take every action necessary when the driver is over the 0.05 limit.
2. The club will prominently display taxi phone numbers near the public telephone.
3. Club members and bar staff will encourage intoxicated patrons to take safe transport home.
4. The club will implement a designated driver program.

## R9.8 Alcohol and Junior Sport

1. In addition to conditions of the club's covering Liquor Licences, club bars will not serve any alcoholic products whilst Mordialloc Cricket Club Junior activities are being held, including: all Junior Matches, MILO Sessions, Junior Training Sessions or Club Functions held for Junior Members;

## R8.4 MCC Code of Conduct – MCC Functions & Facilities

R8.4.1 All MCC Members will conduct themselves in a manner that does not:

- Endanger the safety or health of themselves or fellow members
- Reduce the enjoyment or freedom of fellow members of Club Benefits

R8.4.2 All MCC Facilities are non-smoking environs; smoking will not be permitted on MCC premises.

R8.4.3 The MCC will manage club facilities and functions so as to meet requirements of the Liquor Licensing Control Reform Act 1998.

R8.4.4 The MCC will manage club facilities and functions so as to meet requirements of the “Good Sports Accreditation Program”

R8.4.5 Serving & control of alcohol within MCC Facilities will follow rules & guidelines contained in section R9 of this document.

R8.4.6 All MCC Members will not conduct themselves or incite others in behaviours that verbally or physically abuse or threaten other parties.

## R8.5 MCC ILLEGAL and/or ILLICIT Drug Use Policy

R8.5.1 MCC Members supporters or visitors are not permitted to attend MCC sanctioned games, training sessions, functions or be within a MCE facility under the influence of illegal or illicit drugs;

R8.5.2 MCC Members, supporters or visitors are not permitted to attend MCC sanctioned games, training sessions, functions or be within a MCE facility with illegal or illicit drugs in their possession.

R8.5.3 Breach of the above codes (R8.5.1 & R8.5.2) will result in immediate termination of their MCC membership or in the case of a supporter or visitor their removal from club premises and/or the calling of police.

## R8.6 MCC Vilification & Harassment Policy

R8.6.1 Vilification by MCC Members, Supporters or MCC Function or Match attendees towards other person(s) is not tolerated. Vilification is behaviour(s) (through words or actions) that incites or applies hatred, contempt or ridicule of another person because of their race, gender, sexual orientation, marital status, physical appearance, physical disabilities or religious belief.

R8.6.2 Harassment by MCC Members, Supporters or MCC Function or Match attendees towards other person(s) is not tolerated. Harassment is behaviour that is unwanted, unreturned or unasked for and that humiliates, offends or intimidates others based on their personal attributes, beliefs, characteristics or status.

R8.6.3 Breaches of codes R8.6.1 & R8.6.2 are considered very serious by the MCC, breaches once confirmed through processes detailed in Section R12 of this document can result in immediate termination of membership for the offender.
